Programs for S&T cooperation between Slovenia and Croatia, Montenegro, Bosnia and Herzegovina and Serbia are in the process of realization. Slovenia has ongoing 24 projects with Montenegro, 28 with Bosnia & Herzegovina, 46 with Croatia and with Serbia 50 projects. The Joint Board meeting with Macedonia will be realized in the next days with the adoption of the Working program for 2013.
