

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 Higher Education in BiH is regulated by the Framework Law on Higher Education (2007):

- Defines organization of Higher Education in BiH;
- Defines responsibility of the competent authorities in this area;
- Establishes bodies for implementation of laws and international obligations of BiH;
- Establishes methods of quality assurance in Higher Education.



TEMPUS (1990-2013): Number of selected applications in which the country is involved as coordinator/partner



# PARTICIPATION IN TEMPUS PROGRAMME - IV BY REGIONS


TEMPUS IV: Percentage of submitted applications in which the region is involved as coordinator/partner


