



EIT IN THE WESTERN BALKANS

- The EIT will continue giving priority to its engagement with the Western Balkans, especially through:
 - the enhanced EIT RIS;
 - ➤ the EIT Action to Support the Innovation Capacity of Higher Education Institutions;
 - the Cross-KIC action supporting Strategic Regional Innovations, including a dedicated Western Balkans Work Package.
- At least 5 new EIT Offices will be established in the Western Balkans by 2025.
- Synergies with IPA III & other organisations / initiatives are in place or being sought.





EIT Cross-KIC Regional Strategic Innovations Cluster (2023-2025)

- A dedicated Western Balkans Work Package under the Cross-KIC Regional Strategic Innovations Cluster will kick-off in 2023, containing three key elements:
 - ➤ The INFRA-BOOSTER, a new initiative aimed at supporting the Western Balkan HEIs and Research Centres to make best use of their available infrastructures in the delivery of innovations;
 - Scale-up the whole Western Balkan Region's involvement in the EIT Jumpstarter read more on Western Balkan results here;
 - Establish EIT Community RIS Hubs in all RIS-eligible (2021-2024) Western Balkan economies by end 2024 these Hubs will serve as one-stop-shop for the whole EIT Community, including as a gateway to all EIT KICs, attracting and engaging an increasing number of Western Balkan participants into EIT Community activities.
