Innovation Challanges in B&H

- Global Innovation Index:116 out of 132 countries [1]
 - University-Industry collaboration 129
 - Cluster development 115
 - Innovation culture 116
 - Knowledge creation 132
- Low investment in STI (below 0,1% of GDP) [2]
- Underdeveloped collaboration between R&D institutions and industry
- Fragmented legal /institutional framework for STI
- Lack of strategy on business-level innovation



FIRMA Innovation Initiative

- Create awareness
- Support policy level coordination
- Stimulate innovation development from the demand side
- Improve competences of innovation service providers
- Encourage collaboration between BICs, RDA/LDA and SMEs.
- Facilitate international cooperation
- Support access to available donor programs
- Encourage development of B&H government programs for support of innovation

Country's Innovation System



BICs in B&H

(+)

- A number of LDAs and Technology Centres perform some of the key functions of BICs (support to innovative SMEs – start-ups and existing ones)
- Some have business incubators
- Satisfy many quality criteria number of staff, areas of expertise
- Some support cluster development

(-)

- Only one BIC in BiH is registered with EBN
- Lack of innovation support services (diagnostic, product development, technology transfer, IPR protection)
- Lack of pro-active approach to SMEs among technology centres
- Weak cooperation between science and business support

ISN - Innovation Support Network

Innovation service providers capacity building:

- Initial ISN workshops: awareness raising, best practice presentations, thematic working groups
- Association with EBN European Business Innovation Network
- Development of quality standards and systems for BICs
- Individual BIC action plan development
- Development of transferrable innovation support products/services for dissemination throughout the network
- Closer cooperation with NCPs and access to international innovation networks /programs (CBC, Eureka, FP7, CIP)

New Products Development Initiative

- Assessment of SMEs innovation capacities Innovation scan
- Pre competitive phase support to micro-clusters of SMEs
 - Raising awareness about innovation
 - Learning about technical and technological opportunities
 - Transfer of technology and know how
 - Implementation of technical and technological solutions
- Providing innovation services to selected individual SME's
 - Development of new product ideas
 - Development and design of prototypes
 - Registration of patents and licenses
 - Commercialization of new products
