Analysis Results Synergies between ERDF and FP7/Horizon 2020

- Basis: 1,715 NRW Objective 2 projects analyzed, 33 projects with 95 project partners identified which targeted the establishment of research infrastructures/innovation capacity building, 17 case studies conducted, including extensive interviews with university institutes, research institutions and enterprises
- Research institutes and innovation capacity in new technology fields developed with ERDF funds are playing an active role in top-class research at national and European level (FP7/Horizon 2020) – Examples: ZBT GmbH and the Centre for Telemedicine, Aachen
- Large and small enterprises engaged in research as well as research institutes see themselves - and are striving to be - part of top-class European research
- University academics are particularly successful when they develop and apply for projects in cooperation with affiliated or Fraunhofer institutes
- Established research infrastructures give universities access to the EU's mobility programmes as well as the funding schemes of the European Research Council and raise their appeal for research consortia
