



COST: The networking tool in the ERA and the pre-portal to other ERA funding schemes




Role of COST in the ERA - 3 Strategic Priorities






Dedicated measures for active ITC participation






Average participation in COST Actions, ITCs and other countries






Example of COST members national support



Benefits of participation in a COST Action

scientific	career	networking
work on topics not yet funded by other sources	Get experience in scientific and/ or administrative management (i.e. leading/ organising training schools disseminating research results)	can participate in any H2020 project at the same time
become member of leading scientific networks - without going through a possibly risky and exclusive proposal preparation	participating at short term scientific missions	can participate in more COST Actions at the same time "a la carte" access to existing networks by having an overview of all the running Actions without going through a possibly risky and exclusive proposal preparation
publication	Increasing visibility by hosting and/or participating at additional scientific events	extend one's network
engage with peers	becoming a Grant Holder	reimbursement







Participation figures of the Western Balkan countries




Participation in running Actions 2016-18 (in%)






Leadership positions in running Actions - 2018
